#### Second Leg

### DSCSC COURSE 2018-2019

#### The Take-Off

39th Air Staff Course (DSCSC Course 2018-19) took off early in the morning on 01 April 2018 with 23 Bangladeshi and 10 overseas student officers with the simple but august flag raising ceremony. Most fascinating part of the day was the charismatic speech presented by the Commandant of the DSCSC. His speech was a complete guidance for the student officers full of inspiration but with a cautious note. Orientation to the natural beauty of this photo framed like knowledge village was a unique experience. 'Mirpur Experience', a film on the experience of living in DSCSC campus was shown to the family members of the student officers which made the occasion a memorable one.

#### First Term

First term is known as foundation term. Focus of this term on the knowledge on staff duties, knowledge on operational doctrine of airpower, and development of written communication skill. This ten weeks training curriculum was based on syndicate discussions on various subjects related to single and joint services. ## LIFE AT DSCSC, MIRPUR

### MY STAY AT MIRPUR

Let me start by honestly expressing myself that the first few weeks in Mirpur were confusing, difficult and overwhelming. All too often I would ask myself, why did I even choose to come here? Why didn't just stay in my comfort home? At times, I remember DS asking if I liked Bangladesh. I think I liked this place, was always the answer, but I was definitely not comfortable. Surely many foreign students initially felt the same.

But, soon the coming weeks reassured me, the beauty of the campus, caring faculty, the games at sports complex and friendly atmosphere changed the situation around. Slowly and steadily we became less reserved and more eager, less anxious and more relaxed; and very soon we realized that they were right in saying that Bangladesh is lovely.

We have put together numerous operational and administrative exercises, innumerable COX's and War Games, and many cultural programmes. We have had sleepless nights together in syndicate rooms, written numerous MuktoChintas and Ovibaktis, hosted Guest Speakers and completed a whole Campaign Plan. We made our voices heard, and have learned to be true Mirpurians. We did all these in the past year and yet all these achievements would have remained imaginary and abstracts illusion floating around the lake of Mirpur presented us. Instead of fear and prospect of failure, we saw new possibilities and opportunities to embrace challenges with optimism and belied in Mirpur values.

Having said that, let me be a bit practical about activities and our experience. First in the line was two weeks induction course aimed at introduction of course structure and local culture. The sponsor DS and student took care of us in Mirpur with regards to our course requirements. Civil sponsor played a vital role in exposing us to the rich and fascinating culture of Bangladesh.

I personally had a fascinating time with my civil sponsor. I realized that this was just one of the ways the college extends their hospitality towards foreign students. My civil sponsor was really the man who drove me deeper into the love I have for Bangladesh as a country.

During the course we realized the professionalism of the faculty. Their wealth of knowledge, humanity and compassionate tendencies eased out our learning environment. They were quick at ensuring that our thoughts and approaches converged to a common purpose, despite we were from different military backgrounds. In nutshell, we have learnt very useful concepts that might add value to what we already know. Apart from the academic knowledge, they had always shown concern over our well-being. The faculty showed concern and most cases consoled and comforted individual having welfare problems back home. Their loving kindness would possibly drive any of us into making a comeback if a second coming could have been possible.

Mirpur provided equal opportunities to our families by involving them in the ladies club enrichment programmes. They were frequently exposed to local culture, customs and grooming classes. Study Tour to Chittagong and Cox's Bazar was very exhaustive yet fruitful to experience and embrace new things coming our way.

This is perhaps due to the experience and dedication of the SD and Admin Staff that our stay here has been a win-win situation. We have not only acquired military and academic knowledge, or had the opportunity of having long lasting friendship, but we have also succeeded in tapping the expertise of the SD and Admin Staff in giving out optimum service within constraints. We have a lot to import home as we go back.

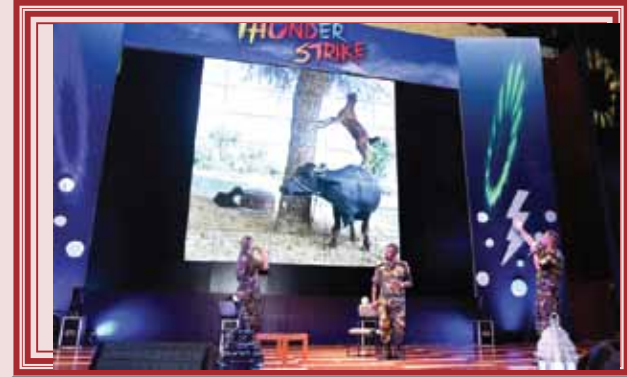
